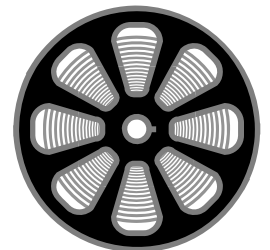
### POW Coffee Morning
