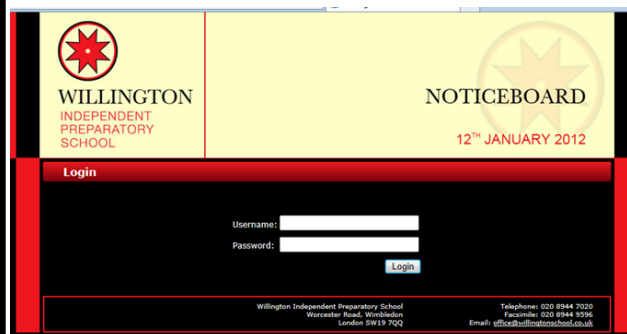


HEADMASTER'S NOTES

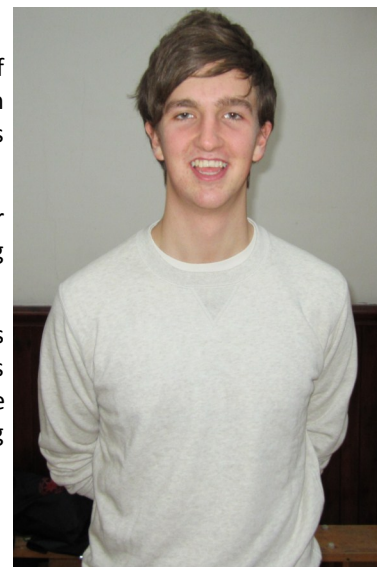

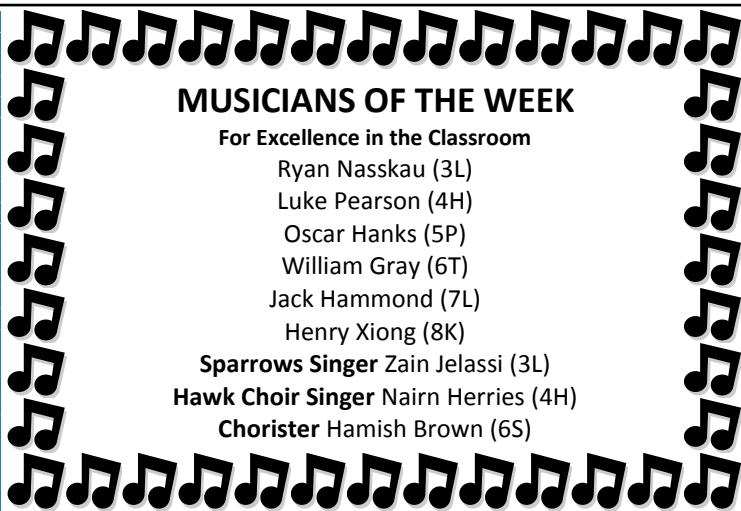
