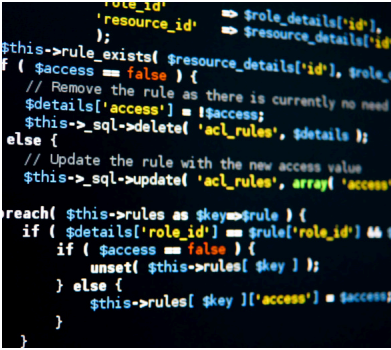
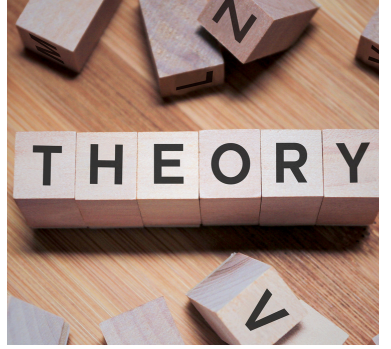

Chess (Y1, Y2, 3/4/5/6)

A classic strategy game that teaches focus, patience and forward planning. Pupils learn to think critically and anticipate outcomes.

Code Club (KS1)

A playful introduction to computer logic using child-friendly programs. Builds confidence in sequencing and early computing concepts.

DOCODE Club (3/4/5/6)

Introduces digital coding in a fun, accessible way. Pupils design games and animations, strengthening logical reasoning and creativity.

Hobbies, Games and Pastimes (5/6)

A sociable club where pupils explore traditional games and puzzles, developing patience, focus and respect for others.

LEGO (KS1, 3/4,) 🎨

Encourages imaginative construction and problem-solving. Pupils plan, build and test their ideas collaboratively, developing spatial awareness and teamwork

LEGO Engineering (5/6) 🎨

A hands-on club where pupils design and build imaginative structures, vehicles and mechanisms. Children work collaboratively to solve engineering challenges, developing creativity, resilience and teamwork. Ideal for budding architects, inventors and problem-solvers who enjoy bringing ideas to life.

Minecraft Club (3/4/5/6) 🎨

Encourages collaborative problem-solving and digital creativity. Children learn to design and build within shared challenges.

Puzzles and Problems (3/4/5/6)

Encourages lateral thinking through logic games, riddles and challenges. Builds persistence and enjoyment of problem-solving.

Python Coding (5/6)

Teaches more advanced programming concepts, creating resilience and analytical thinking. Perfect for children ready to explore real-world coding skills.

Touch Typing

Develops essential typing speed and accuracy through structured practice. Builds digital confidence and supports writing fluency.

Art Masters (5/6)

A chance for pupils with a passion for art to refine their technique and experiment with new media. They learn how to plan, create and evaluate their work – developing both creative confidence and artistic skill.

Art Portfolio Club - By Invitation Only

Cooking (EYFS, KS1, 3/4/5/6)

Practical, hands-on fun in the kitchen! Pupils learn about ingredients, nutrition and teamwork while developing independence and life skills. Notes: please make allergies and dietary requirements known to Daniela beforehand.

M:Tech (Music Technology)

Children compose and record their own music using specialist software. It builds digital skills, creativity and confidence in using technology purposefully.

Painting (EYFS, Y1, Y2, 3/4/5/6)

A joyful and calming club where children experiment with colour, texture and form. Painting helps develop fine motor control and self-expression through creativity.

Podcasting Club (5/6) 🎧

An engaging introduction to researching, scripting, interviewing and audio editing. Pupils work together to create their own episodes, developing communication skills, confidence and digital literacy. By the end of term, the group will produce a polished Willington podcast series that reflects their interests and ideas.

Sewing (KS1, 3/4/5/6)

Introduces basic stitches, fabric design and hand-eye coordination. Children enjoy making small projects and learning the value of perseverance and precision.

Warhammer (5/6) 💡

Blends creative design with strategy, helping children plan ahead and think critically while crafting models and stories.

Basketball (EYFS, 3/4/5/6)

Fast-paced and inclusive, basketball promotes teamwork, endurance and quick thinking. Notes: bring trainers.

Climbing (3/4, 5/6)

Promotes courage, problem-solving and trust. Builds physical confidence and resilience.

EzeeSport (KS1, 3/4)

Introduces core athletic skills in a fun, inclusive way. Builds agility, teamwork and confidence. Notes: pupils wear school uniform and trainers.

Football (All years)

Builds teamwork, communication and sportsmanship. Pupils learn to play fairly and celebrate shared success.

Golf (4/5/6)

Improves precision, concentration and patience. Teaches calmness and self-discipline.

Notes: Pupils taken to Caddi Club in Wimbledon Quarter from 16:30 to 17:30. Pick up from the venue at 17:30.

Gymnastics Club (EYFS, 3/4)

Develops balance, coordination and strength through structured routines and fun challenges.

Notes: Children attend barefoot and will need a pair of shorts or leggings to change into if need be.

Hockey (3/4)

Encourages coordination and cooperation through team play. Develops agility, strategy and mutual respect.

Judo (3/4/5/6)

Teaches discipline, control and respect while building strength and confidence in a structured environment. Notes: PE kit can be worn when first starting the club. Regular attendees to wear judogi uniform please.

Multi-Sports (EYFS)

Gives younger pupils the chance to try a variety of games, developing coordination and a love of physical activity. Notes: pupils to bring trainers.

Table Tennis (3/4/5/6)

Sharpens focus and reflexes while encouraging friendly competition and self-improvement.

Drama and Movement (EYFS)

Through simple storytelling, song and dance, our youngest pupils develop body awareness, rhythm and expressive confidence.

LAMDA (EYFS, KS1, 3/4)

Structured speech and drama training that builds communication, diction and poise. Pupils learn to express themselves clearly and perform with confidence.

Music Scholarship - By Invitation Only

Music Theory (4/5/6) 💡

Teaches the foundations of music reading and composition, deepening understanding for pupils who play instruments or sing.

Musical Theatre (3/4)

Combines singing, dancing and acting to develop coordination and stagecraft. It's wonderful for children who love performing and expressing emotion through movement.

Orchestra (3/4/5/6)

Brings instrumentalists together to rehearse and perform as an ensemble. Pupils learn cooperation, timing and musical awareness.

Sparrows Choir (KS1)

Introduces younger pupils to ensemble singing through fun, accessible songs. It helps build pitch recognition, rhythm and joy in performing.

Woodwind Ensemble (3/4/5/6)

A smaller group for woodwind players to perform together, refining musical technique and confidence through teamwork.

Mandarin

For the youngest children, a playful introduction to Mandarin through songs, stories and simple vocabulary, building early language confidence and cultural curiosity. Older children will develop speaking, reading and listening skills, encouraging them to explore language structure and Chinese culture with growing independence.

Spanish (KS1)

Encourages early language learning through fun, interactive activities. Pupils gain cultural awareness and confidence in communication.

Eco-Club (3/4/5/6)

Explores environmental issues through hands-on activities. Pupils learn responsibility, teamwork and care for their world.

Enrichment (Nursery–Y2)

A varied programme of experiences designed to broaden curiosity and imagination. Encourages independence and enthusiasm for learning. Notes: Spaces are available for every child to enjoy enrichment, but all sessions should be booked via the SOCS platform into the club.
